Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you for all your continued support during these difficult times. I appreciate that it can be frustrating when the children are asked to isolate at home. I hope that you have found the remote learning content accessible and our support useful.

As you may be aware, we are taking a range of measures to reduce the risk of COVID19 virus in our school and these are outlined in our risk assessment.

Following the recent bubble closure for the Spain and Ireland classes, we have reviewed the measures in place, taking into consideration that this is the second closure since September and the benefits and risks of having the two classes together in one bubble. We have now made the decision to separate the two classes into separate bubbles from Monday 23rd November. This will mean that the two classes will not be together inside the building or when learning or playing outside to try. This will minimise the impact on the amount of children that would need to self-isolate in the unfortunate event that we need to close a bubble again.
